Topics covered include: managing potty training, chewing, jumping, barking, nipping, preparing for vet exams, play group safety, puppy mini tricks, basic manners, and becoming best buddies. This class is the perfect preparation for Family Dog classes!

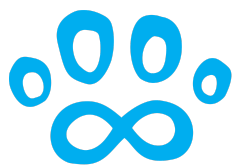
Any 5 Consecutive Tuesdays at 6:30 pm. No more waiting for class to start!

Completed and confirmed registration is required. No drop-ins allowed, to ensure a safe, healthy class. Proof of vaccination required before you receive enrollment confirmation.

Prerequisite: Proof of vaccination required before you receive enrollment confirmation. Pup may start as young as 8 weeks old, and we recommend you enroll your pup at no older than 12 weeks old to ensure receiving the full value of this class. Age limit for attendance in this class is 17 weeks old. This age limit ensures a safer play group for your puppy.

FOUNDATION COURSES (continued)

FAMILY DOG part 1 of 2 part course

You will learn how to teach your dog the essential skills that are the foundation of polite manners. Sit, lie down, relax, stand for vet or grooming, stay, leave it, come, walk nice, and prompt responses to your requests will be introduced in this first part of our two part Family Dog course.

5 Sundays at 1:00 pm starting October 29 (for dogs 1 year old and up)

5 Sundays at 2:15 pm starting October 29 (for dogs 17 weeks to 1 year old)

Tuition for Family Dog Part 1 only: \$95

Prepaid tuition for Family Dog Part 1 and Part 2: \$170 (3 month maximum gap between classes)

Prerequisite: Proof of current vaccinations is required prior to receiving confirmation of registration. Rabies, Distemper, Parvo required. Bordetella and Influenza highly recommended. Clear of parasites. Your dog must be accepting and comfortable in a group with strangers and other dogs. If your dog is over-the-top excited, barks excessively, lunges towards other dogs, or is extremely anxious or nervous, we offer extra help for you and your dog with private lesson training options.

FAMILY DOG part 2 of 2 part course

This course continues to build on the foundation skills learned in Family Dog Part 1, with tips on how to improve reliable responses and practice for real life situations. This class will introduce a majority of the basic skills defined in the Canine Good Citizen program. You and your dog will have a chance to sample some of our popular fun activities, such as tricks and obstacle course elements.
