Low Cost Spay and Neuter Options for Dogs

These programs are only intended for dogs who you own. These are not intended for found pets that you do not intend to keep.

If available for your county of residence, the county specific programs (i.e. programs that are only eligible to residents of that county) are the best options. County specific options are <u>not</u> listed for Chatham or Rockingham county.

If a county program is not available, or if you do not qualify for the county program, please skip to the non-county specific section on page 4. **Important note about pricing for non-county specific programs/clinics**: The price listed is the base price for a standard surgery. If the dog is in heat, pregnant, has an undescended testical, or any other medical condition that makes surgery more complicated, the cost will be higher at most clinics. If you do not have proof of a rabies vaccine or want to add any additional vaccines when the dog is spayed/neutered, this will also likely result in additional costs. Please review the pricing and policy information in detail on the clinic's website.

This guide is intended as a reference to help community members easily access information about low-cost spay and neuter options in this area. After the pet is dropped off by the owner, they travel in individual carriers in a heated/air conditioned truck to a clinic. After surgery the pet will spend the night on a clean, dry surface for the surgical glue to dry under vet observation, and return to Yanceyville on the following Tuesday morning at 10:00 am. Paper copy of the pet's rabies vaccination certificate is required (tag is not sufficient). An extra \$10 will be charged for all pets without proper rabies paperwork. There is an additional charge for dogs over 70 lbs. Pet carriers will be provided for owners who do not have them. Some extra services and vaccines are also available for extra cost. Appointments are required for all services and surgeries. Call APS of Caswell at 336 694 4921 to book an appointment.
