If available for your county of residence, the county specific programs (i.e. programs that are only eligible to residents of that county) are the typically best options. County specific options are <u>not</u> listed for Chatham or Rockingham county.

If a county specific program is not available, or if you do not qualify for the county program, please skip to the non-county specific section on page 4. Important note about pricing for non-county specific programs/clinics: The price listed is the base price for a standard surgery. If the cat is in heat, pregnant, has an undescended testical, or any other medical condition that makes surgery more complicated, the cost will be higher at most clinics. If you do not have proof of a rabies vaccine or want to add any additional vaccines when the cat is spayed/neutered, this will also likely result in additional costs. Please review the pricing and policy information in detail on the clinic's website.


